The student is enthusiastic about learning outside the classroom. They put considerable time and effort into homework, often going over and above what is required. Deadlines are always met both in and outside of the classroom. Work is always diligently organised and they take exceptional pride in their work.</p>

Including extra reading/research to improve their breadth of knowledge.</i>	<i>Utilising all of the time available, both inside and outside of lesson to ensure all learning is maximised.</i>
3 Stars ***	<p>This student generally works to the best of their ability. In class they are usually enthusiastic, active learners who show a willingness to ask and answer questions appropriately. When they make mistakes they usually put effort into improving their work and are keen to act upon advice given.</p>	<p>This student always does their homework and is generally enthusiastic about learning outside the classroom. It is clear that sufficient time and effort has been put into producing a good piece of work.</p>	<p>This student is usually well prepared to learn and usually arrives to lessons with the correct equipment/kit. Most deadlines are met. Work is generally well organised and they take sufficient pride in their work.</p>
To Move Up To ***	<i>Student must focus consistently and ensure their motivation/effort is improved, especially when learning new topics or areas they find difficult.</i>	<i>Student must ensure answers are fully developed and presented neatly. Homework should reflect that suitable time & effort has been spent on it.</i>	<i>Student must ensure all deadlines are met, and improvements are made with the presentation and organisation in their work.</i>
2 Stars **	<p>The student's attitude to learning could be improved because they sometimes lack motivation and enthusiasm for learning. They need prompting to stay on task or answer questions. They are sometimes reluctant to put effort into trying new things or work beyond minimum expectations.</p>	<p>The student attempts homework, but their approach to work outside the classroom does not reflect a desire to do more than the minimum required.</p>	<p>On a number of occasions, the student arrives to lessons without the correct equipment/kit. Deadlines are not always met. Work can sometimes be disorganised and they do not take sufficient pride in their work.</p>
To Move Up To **	<i>Student must engage in learning, avoiding distracting themselves and/or others. Student must fully embrace KES 'Behaviour For Learning' and follow all aspects without fail.</i>	<i>Student must complete all homework set on 'Show My Homework'; on time, to a good standard, and displaying the quality & effort expected of them.</i>	<i>Student must take pride & care in preparing for lessons and taking part in lessons. This includes having the correct equipment & using it to the best of their ability.</i>
1 Star *	<p>The student's attitude to learning is poor because they are disengaged, often unprepared to learn and are not motivated to take responsibility for their own progress. A poor level of effort means that work is often below the minimum expectations set by the teacher.</p>	<p>The student has a negative attitude towards homework and does not willingly complete it without teacher intervention.</p>	<p>The student is rarely prepared for lessons and does not bring the correct equipment/kit. Deadlines are rarely met. Work is disorganised and they do not take pride in their work.</p>
